Not illustrated. 1900 Excerpt: .Troughton Simms attach to all their three-screw combinations of parallel plates connected with theodolites, a centering locking-plate, in which provision is made to allow of a motion of 1 in. in any direction for the adjustment of the plumb-bob over the station point, the centering-plate being tightened after setting over the station by a screwed washer-plate. This plate is somewhat similar in shape to the washer-plate shown in fig. 21, but has a raised thumb-piece at its outer edge, for screwing up or down the collar which holds the vertical axis of the instrument. By this means the locking-plate and the instrument are both clamped to the tripod-stand, or released without the addition of extra clamp screws. Messrs. Troughton Simms also make a framed stand, shown in fig, 25, with an arrangement of plates shown in section in fig. 26, and in plan in fig. 27...
